
The Southeast Region is having a rally in Lumberton, North Carolina, June 13-16 at the KOA. It would be great if Florida is represented at the rally, so register today.






⇒ A Note from Brenda L. Hickman:

Are you familiar with the Tin Can Tourist? This organization began in 1919, so this year is the 100th Centennial year. This organization was most likely the first organized camping organization. I researched to see if NCHA was an out-growth of the Tin Can Tourist, but they were not. The TCT died out in the 1970s and forward. In 1990, Forest Bone and his wife re-organized and brought the TCT back to life. The license for the name was such that they can continue to use the TCT name. Many of the members have vintage trailers that they have restored and now enjoy using. They are planning to caravan in Michigan and Florida and replicate the original caravan from Arcadia to Sarasota, Florida. They will camp at the fairgrounds here in Sarasota for several days while they do some sight-seeing.



FLORIDA STATE ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

FSA SCHOLARSHIP

An annual college scholarship may be awarded by the Florida State Association of FCRV to an FCRV member or a child/grandchild greatgrandchild of an FCRV member residing in the state of Florida. This annual scholarship is awarded in the belief that campers wish to be responsible for the selection and encouragement of students who will be guardians of our rich wildlife heritage, leaders in conservation and development of outdoor recreation.

The FSA Scholarship Fund, which is basically supported by FCRV members of the State of Florida, will consist of all interest earned during the year plus donations marked for the current year's distribution. An exact stipend cannot be guaranteed.

- 1. The candidate, if a minor, must be a dependent child or grandchild or greatgrandchild of a Florida resident who has been a member of FCRV for at least two years. Grandparents and grandchild and great grandchild must both be residents of the State of Florida. An adult (persons 21 or over) whether dependent or not, may apply as long as they or their parent or grandparent have been in FCRV for the two years previous.
- 2. The candidate must be planning to attend an accredited institution of higher learning or a technical school that will qualify the candidate to receive a diploma or license upon completion.
- 3. The student who pursues a program of wildlife management, conservation, and/or forestry in an accredited institute of higher education will be given precedence.
- 4. The candidate must have an academic standing in the upper one-half of their class and combined SAT scores of 1000 or better. Applicants currently enrolled in college must have a cumulative 2.7 grade point average for the time enrolled.
- 5. Consideration will be given to general maturity, leadership, activities within FCRV and the goals of the candidate as related to the objectives of FCRV and FSA.
- 6. Equal consideration will be given to high school seniors, college students, and former recipients of the scholarships.
- 7. Re-application for the scholarship must be made every year.

SELECTION OF FSA SCHOLAR

Selection will be made by the Scholarship Board of Directors. Selection will be made at the Spring FSA Campout and the name of the recipient(s) will be announced at that campout.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR FSA SCHOLARSHIP

The following information must be in the possession of the Scholarship Director by May 1st of the year the award is to be given.

- 1. Official Application Form
- 2. Certified copy of high school transcript and official record of College Board scores (SAT, ACT, etc.) for HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS.
- 3. Proof of admission to an accredited institution of higher learning or a technical school which will grant a diploma or license upon completion.
- 4. Certified copy of college transcripts up to the date of application for <u>COLLEGE STUDENTS OR TECHNICAL SCHOOL STU-DENTS.</u>
- 5. Two letters o recommendation (relatives not acceptable). Suggested: a school teacher or administrator, and an FCRV member from Florida.
- 6. Photostat copy of parents/ grandparents FCRV membership card, or own card if over 21.
- 7. Former applicants may reapply each year they wish to be considered by submitting: a)Certified copy of college transcript to date of application.
 - b)Photostat copy of parents/grandparents FCRV membership card, or own card if over 21.

FAILURE TO SUBMIT ANY OF THE ABOVE MAY CAUSE YOUR APPLICATION TO BE REJECTED.

CREOLE PRALINES

2 cups granulated sugar

1 cup dark or light brown sugar

1 stick (1/4 pound butter)

1 cup milk

2 tablespoons Karo syrup

4 cups pecan halves

Put all ingredients except the pecans in a 3 quart saucepan and cook for about 20 minutes after boiling starts, stirring occasionally. Add the pecans and cook the mixture until the liquid forms a soft ball when a little is dropped into cold water. Stir well and then drop by spoonsful on waxed paper. Place a few sheets of newspaper beneath the waxed paper. I find it convenient to place a small table near the stove, over which I put a few sheets of newspaper and then put the waxed paper over that.
