






How To Sign Up For MSCA Website

Many members of FCRV have expressed an interest in signing up to post pictures and comments on the FCRV web site. Because the process is not as easy as we might like step by step instructions are included in this article.


STEP 1

From your web browser go to <http://www.shutterstock.com>. Click on the sign up button at the top of the page. If you already have a Shutterstock account you can skip this step.




STEP 2

A sign up dialog box will appear similar to that shown on the left. Depending on which browser you are using the dialog box may vary. Fill in all of the boxes. When all of the have been filled in you should click on Join Now. This will create a Shutterstock account but does not yet give you member access to the MSCA website.



STEP 3

The next step is to go to <http://www.mofcrv.org> or <https://fcrvmsca.shutterstock.com>. Both of these links will take you to the same page. Click on the Sign up button at the top right of the page.



STEP 4

A dialog box similar to that shown below will appear. Click on the Sign in at the bottom of the dialog box. You will be asked to sign in to your Shutterfly account.

STEP 6

At this point your request has been sent to the “Owner / Administrator” of the site. If you are a member of MSCA you will be granted access to add pictures, comments to pictures, etc. When access has been granted you will receive an email indicating that you are now a member of the site. Future logins will only require you to go to the MSCA site and login as a member.

STEP 7

If you are also a member of Slow Travelers you will need to request membership on that site also. The address for the Slow Travelers site is <https://missourislowtravelers.shutterfly.com>. At this point just follow steps 3, 4, and 5.

Grace is when God gives us what we don't deserve and mercy is when God doesn't give us what we do deserve.


So for this next busy couple of months, may you be shown a random act of kindness and pass it along.

1 cup milk

1/2 tsp salt

Sift together the flour, sugar, salt and baking powder
Add to beaten egg and milk (Mother usually puts egg in milk, beats then adds dry ingredients).
Bake at 350 until toothpick comes out clean.


Many thanks to all who participated (which was everyone who attended!) Looking forward to the event in 2019 - Theme TBD but actively seeking suggestions.....please.


