
September 11th - 14th finds us back at Cliffside which we really love. They have large grassy sites.

Sorry, your are in the wrong place. If I said anything, it would be outdated by the time you read this. But even with the many changes, I ask all to follow what our State and National leaders are telling us to do. I feel (and hope) they are telling us to do what they are being told by science.
(Sometimes I just wish they would set an example by following their own directions!)

going down the interstate! And before you ask, I did NOT check the undercarriage before this happened! But I have checked what I can now! (I replaced the steel and all the bolts holding it!) Just another area to 'look' at every once in a while. I intend to treat the undercarriage (as much of it that I can) with some rust preventive/control paint as I can get to. Also going to check the rear stabilizers for signs of rust.

He found the spare tire (and its steel holder) laying on the ground. The bolts on one side apparently 'rusted' to the point that they broke! (Our 5er is 12 years old.) Just think of what could have happened if they broke while

Just when we thing we check everything on our campers, something new happens that we never thought of checking. Keep your eyes & ears open for anything that just does not sound or look right. In the aircraft business, they call this 'required' inspections for internal integrity.

Stay safe, do your 'walk a round's', follow safe health practices.
