2021 PARADE INFORMATION

Enclosed in this packet is a copy of the parade Registration Form and Categories of Entry.

The parade route will be approximately one mile in length. The parade will form at the school grounds next to the fairgrounds, where there will be ample parking and form up area. Disassembling of floats will be done at the fairgrounds. A copy of the parade route will be included with the packet handed out at the State Parade Marshal meeting.

JUDGING: Based on development of the parade theme "Wander Wisconsin" all entries will be judged on originality and handiwork.

AWARDS:

- 1. One award shall be given in each category section, plus participation certificates to each registered unit in the parade.
- 2. Parade Stealer: All units in the seven categories are eligible. This is awarded to the unit accumulating the most points.
- 3. Trustee's Award: All units in the first six categories are eligible. This award will be chosen by the Trustees and those they choose to help.
- 4. Both the Parade Stealer and Trustee's Award winners are eligible to win the awards in their section.

PARADE GUIDELINES

Following is a list of Guidelines to follow in preparing for the parade. Although these Guidelines are not official FCRV Guidelines, most of them have been used in the past and seem to fit most situations.

- 1. No particular dimensions for floats and vehicles have been established. It is suggested to stay within about 9 feet in width due to traveling on roadways. A building will be available where most all floats can be built.
- 2. All portions of the float and tow vehicle must be decorated. (NOTE: There are points to be gained by decorating your tow vehicle.)
- 3. Aprons must extend to not more than 6" from the ground to hide wheels.
- 4. Floats will have neat and legible titles attached to each side.
- 5. All motorized floats and vehicles <u>must</u> carry an ABC fire extinguisher, easily seen and accessible, **no exceptions**. There should be at least two persons walking with the float who know the location and use of the extinguisher.
- 6. Numbers supplied by the Parade Committee will be attached to the float and/or the tow vehicle. Numbers will be passed out at meeting on Monday morning of Campvention.
- 7. Commercial advertising is not permitted on FCRV chapter or state/provincial floats.
- 8. Floats sponsored by local business or commercial exhibitors attending the Campvention may display their advertising with prior approval of the Parade Chairman.
- 9. Parade Marshals will be spaced at intervals to help with problems, keep spacing at 20' intervals, etc. They will be obeyed at all times. Their instructions must be adhered to.
- 10. All units must complete the entire parade route unless a breakdown occurs.
- 11. In case of breakdown, float and vehicle will be pushed out of the line of march. Parade Marshals will assist when necessary.
- 12. Parade units will not stop once the parade has begun, except on the instructions of the Parade Marshals.
- 13. No items may be thrown from the floats. Candy, etc., may be handed out by walkers but may not be thrown from moving vehicles (for safety reasons).
- 14. Disposal of float materials in proper containers will be required.
- 15. Previewing of all floats will be done before the start of the Parade. Check program booklet for time and location. Floats must be completed and ready for the previewing as they will appear in the Parade.
- 16. There will be a meeting on ______ place to be announced (Please check the Campvention program for details).

PARADE CATEGORIES

- 1. There shall be seven categories for Parade judging (a total of fifteen sections), plus the Parade Stealer and President's Award.
- 2. There shall be one award given in each section (that has participated), plus participation certificates to each registered unit in the Parade.
- 3. The type of awards shall be determined by the Campvention Steering Committee. (Participation Certificates shall be furnished by the Campvention.)
- 4. The FCRV Marching Band will be assigned a prominent area in the Parade and each member shall receive a Participation Certificate.
- 5. FCRV Program or Committee floats will be judges in Category seven only.

CATEGORIES:

1. CHAPTER FLOATS:

Section A: Walking Units – all members walking (including no motorized displays).

Section B: Small Units – motorized units under 8' in length

Section C: Large Units – motorized units over 8' in length

2. TEEN CHAPTER FLOATS:

Section A: Walking Units – all members walking (including no motorized displays).

Section B: Large and Small Units – motorized

3. STATE/PROVINCIAL FLOATS:

Section A: Walking Units – all members walking (including no motorized displays).

Section B: Large and Small Units – motorized

4. STATE/PROVINCIAL TEEN FLOATS:

Section A: Walking Units – all members walking (including no motorized displays).

Section B: Large and Small Units – motorized

5. ALL TEEN QUEEN FLOATS:

Section A: Large Floats

Section B: Small Floats – cars or station wagons

6. INDIVIDUAL MEMBER FAMILIES FLOATS:

Section A: Walking Units – all members walking (including no motorized displays).

Section B: Large and Small Units – motorized

7. NATIONAL ENTRY FLOATS:

(Conservation, National Retirees, Wildlife, Field Directors, all entries dealing with a National Program)

Section A: Walking Units – all members walking (including no motorized displays).

Section B: Large and Small Units – motorized

8. SPECIAL AWARDS:

Parade Stealer: All units in the above categories are eligible.

This award will be given to the unit accumulating the most points.

Trustee's Award: All units in the first six categories are eligible. The President shall decide

each year what to judge the award on.

Both the Parade Stealer and Trustee's Award winners are eligible to win the awards in their own Category/Section.

Since the more complex floats often can only show all their features when they are parading, previewing can only be done to familiarize the judges with the floats and the final judging will be done from the reviewing stands.
