Grilled Strip Steak with Chimichurri

1 cup cilantro, roughly chopped	2 tbsp olive oil
1/4 cup white onion, in 1/4 inch dice	1 tsp dried oregano
2 garlic cloves, finely minced	1 tsp crushed red pepper
2 tbsp apple cider vinegar	Kosher salt and fresh ground pepper, to taste

2 (10 to 16 oz) strip steaks (1 1/2 inch thick or more)

Prepare the chimichurri. Place cilantro in a small mixing bowl. Add remaining ingredients; cover and refrigerate for 3 or more hours to allow the flavors to meld together.

Preheat outdoor grill to 450 F, and clean the grate. Season steaks with salt and pepper; let them sit before cooking.

Oil the grate, then grill the steaks to desired doneness; for medium-rare, cook to 145 F internal temperature. Plate the steaks, then rest for 5 minutes prior to cutting (go and have a glass of red wine while you 'rest'). Slice steaks and drizzle with chimichurri, or serve sauce on the side. Makes 2 to 4 servings.

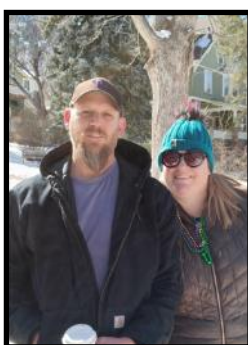

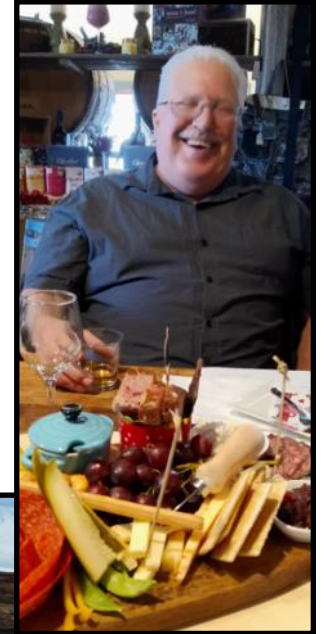

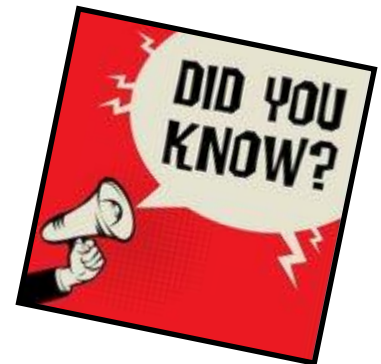

Sweet and Spicy Roasted Brussels Sprouts

Preheat oven to 425.

| 2 lbs. Brussels sprouts | 1 tbsp Sriracha sauce |
| 1/4 cup olive oil, divided | 1 tbsp honey |
| 1/2 tsp coarse sea salt | 2 tsp lime juice |

Place Brussels sprouts in a bowl of cool water. Any debris will float down to the bottom of the bowl. Lift Brussels sprouts out, into a colander. Pat dry and then trim off the bottoms, then cut the Brussels sprouts in half lengthwise.

Place Brussels sprouts on a large rimmed baking sheet in one layer, and toss with 2 tbsp oil and salt. (Don't overcrowd them; use 2 baking sheets if needed.) Place baking sheet in the center of the oven and roast for 25 minutes, until Brussels sprouts are browned with caramelized edges.

Meanwhile, whisk together Sriracha, honey, lime juice and 2 tbsp oil. Use a spatula to move the Brussels sprouts to a serving bowl; pour on the sweet and spicy sauce to taste. Makes 4 to 6 servings.
