After dinner put your dancing shoes on as there will be a 5-piece band to dance the night away.

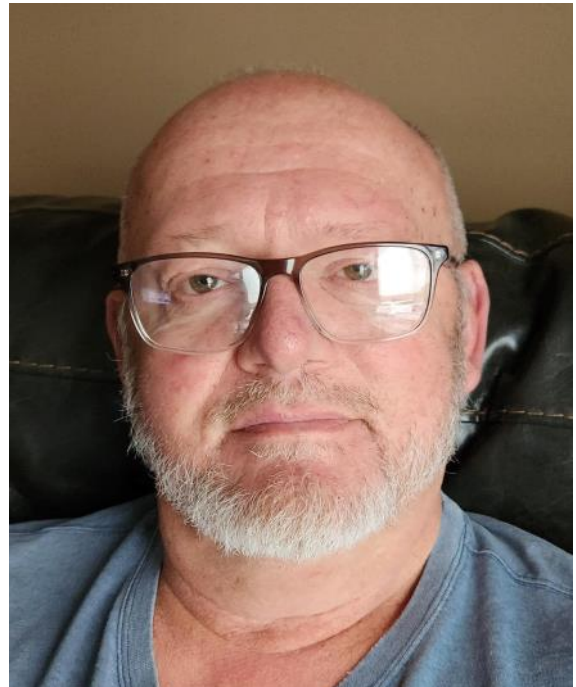
Plan on joining us at the Retiree Rally for fun, adventures, and the making of new memories.

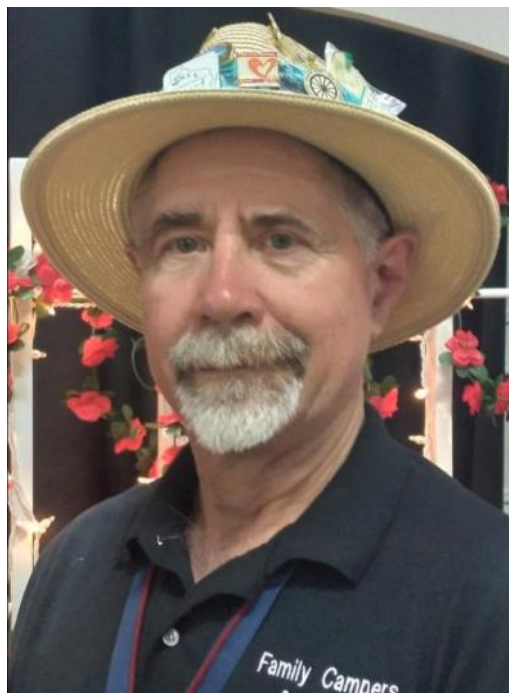

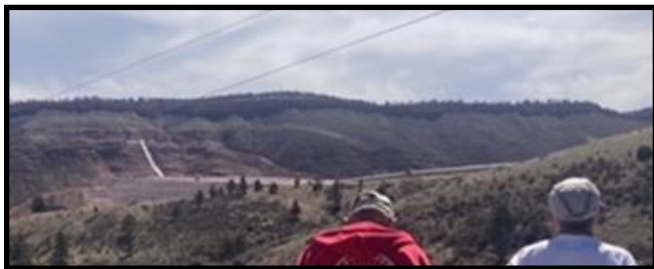

“When I volunteer, I can be walking dogs, cleaning the facility, doing laundry and dishes, and help to prepare for adoption events. I hope that all I do as a volunteer contributes to improving their lives and a chance at finding a forever home.”

Last year the Colorado Cruisers assisted with donating blankets, towels, sheets, and plastic bags to help with bedding and cleaning supplies. These donations and acts of kindness help offset costs of caring for the rescues that come from traumatic situations in overcrowded high kill shelters or puppy mills shut down throughout the United States.

This summer we plan to help with painting inside the facility and providing needed repairs around the facility and grounds.

Mediterranean Orzo Salad



Ingredients

1/4 c. extra virgin olive oil

1 whole lemon, juiced

1 clove garlic, minced

Salt and pepper, to taste

12 oz. orzo pasta, cooked, drained, and cooled

1 c. red grape or cherry tomatoes

1 c. yellow grape or cherry tomatoes

1 c. kalamata olives, halved

1 c. crumbled feta cheese (optional), plus more to serve

1 c. chickpeas, drained.

1/2 red onion, diced

3 tbsp. minced fresh parsley, plus more to serve

- 1 | In a jar or bowl, mix together the oil, lemon juice, garlic, salt, and pepper until totally combined.
- 2 | To a large mixing bowl, add the orzo and all other ingredients. Pour the dressing over the top and stir to combine. Taste and adjust the seasonings. Refrigerate for at least an hour before serving. Top with more feta, if using, and parsley just before serving.
